*Please state the Halacha and the reason:*

1. An egg was not checked for blood and subsequently mixed into food.
2. An egg with a blood spot was mistakenly mixed into a bowl of other food.  
Is there a difference between caged eggs and free range eggs?
3. What is the benefit of cooking at least three eggs?  
What's if two eggs were fried and one was found to have a blood spot?
4. What is the Halacha if cold meat touches cold cheese?
5. Cold milk spilled onto cold meat: (1) raw meat (2) cooked meat.
6. Cold milk was left in a meat pot for 24 hours.  
What is the Halacha of the milk? What is the Halacha of the pot?
7. May one bake bread and meat simultaneously in the same oven?  
(1) If the meat is covered (2) If both are uncovered
8. A tray of lasagna (dairy) covered with foil was baked in a meat oven.
9. Explain the principle of נותן טעם בר נותן טעם (נ"ט בר נ"ט)?
10. Explain the principle of נותן טעם לפגם?
11. Pasta was cooked in a meat pot בן יומיו: May the pasta be eaten together with cheese?
12. Pasta was cooked in a meat pot בן יומיו: May the pasta be served on dairy dishes?
13. May one initially cook pasta in a meat pot בן יומיו to be served on dairy dishes?
14. Pasta was cooked in a non meat pot בן יומיו: May the pasta be eaten together with cheese?
15. May one initially cook pasta in a non meat pot בן יומיו to be eaten together with cheese?

16. A hot potato was placed on a meat counter: May the potato be eaten with cheese?
17. Vegetable soup that was cooked in a meat pot: May it be warmed in a dairy pot?
18. An onion was cut with a clean non יטו בן יטו meat knife: May it be eaten together with cheese?
19. Is it okay to serve non-dairy creamer with coffee with desert after a meat meal?
20. Eating dairy on the same table with a friend who is eating meat.
21. Why must one wait 6 hours between eating meat and dairy?
22. May one eat dairy when one is not sure if a full six hours passed since eating meat.
23. If one merely licks a meat dish with his tongue, must one wait 6 hours?
24. What are the guidelines for children regarding waiting between meat and dairy?
25. If one eats only a potato from the chulent must he wait 6 hours before eating pizza?
26. Must one wait six hours after eating an onion cut with a meat knife?
27. May one eat an onion cut with a dairy knife within 6 hours of eating meat?
28. Must one wait six hours after eating a פתוחה food cooked in a meat pot?
29. Must one wait 6 hours after eating French fries that were fried in the same oil as chicken nuggets?
30. What is our custom regarding meat after dairy?
31. List 2 common types of aged cheese after which one must wait 6 hours before eating meat.
32. May one use challah left over from the Shabbos meal for a grilled cheese sandwich?
33. If one cut cold cheese with a meat knife.  
What is the Halacha of the cheese? What is the Halacha of the knife?
34. Describe the process of נעיצה בקרקע. What does this accomplish?
35. Hot meat was cut with a dairy knife. Does the knife require הגעלה or is נעיצה sufficient?

36. Which is more severe when cut with a non-kosher knife: hot meat or a cold onion?
37. A בן יומיו dairy spoon was inserted into a hot pot of meat.  
What is the Halacha of the food, pot and spoon?
38. A non בן יומיו dairy spoon was inserted into a hot pot of meat.  
What is the Halacha of the food, pot and spoon?
39. What's if one is unsure whether the utensil in question was used within the past 24 hours?
40. A spoon was used for cereal and milk this morning. Does that make it a בן יומיו dairy spoon?
41. A non בן יומיו dairy lid was placed onto a boiling pot of meat.  
What is the Halacha of the food, pot and lid?
42. When a בן יומיו dairy spoon is inserted into hot chicken soup, does it make a difference if the soup was still in the original cooking pot vs if it was already transferred into a bowl?
43. A hot pot of chicken soup was placed on a clean dairy counter.
44. A hot pot of meat was placed on top of a puddle of milk that had spilled on the counter.  
What is the Halacha of the pot? What is the Halacha of the meat?
45. May one cook fish in a clean meat pot?
46. May one bake fish and meat simultaneously in the same oven?  
(1) If the fish or meat is covered (2) If both the fish and meat are uncovered
47. Is it okay to eat fish with milk or cheese?
48. Meat and dairy dishes (dirty) were mistakenly soaked together in a pail (כלי שני) of hot water.
49. One mistakenly scrubbed a dairy dish with a meaty sponge under hot water from the sink:  
a) Both dishes were clean from actual meat and milk residue  
b) At least one of the dishes had meat or milk residue and no soap was used  
c) Soap was used in the initial stages of the washing  
d) At least one of the dishes had residue and soap was added at a later stage of the washing  
e) Meat or milk residue with no soap, but not sure if water is יד סולדת בו
